## **drumMUSTER**

**drumMUSTER** will be working with all relevant Shire Councils to ensure our facilities are open and available to collect and store empty agvet containers for recycling.

The usual **drumMUSTER** cleanliness standards have been relaxed for this recovery program, to ensure containers are diverted from landfill during the clean up process.

You do not have to be the original owner of the containers. Containers without labels and with dirt and other stains due to flood conditions will be accepted.

Containers with residual liquid will not be accepted at **drumMUSTER** sites. Please refer to the ChemClear programs flood recovery information.

## **ChemClear®**

The ChemClear program are seeking funds from the Federal/State QLD Recovery Task Force to support the collection and disposal of found, inherited and/or unwanted agvet chemicals from Flood and Cyclone affected areas of QLD.

ChemClear have offered the Task Force our program's services to enable a safe agvet chemical cleanup

and disposal from Councils and persons who hold, have found or have inherited these products. The chemicals may be unknown, unlabelled or inherited as a result of the recent floods and cyclone.

If you have unwanted agvet chemicals and require a disposal service you can register them with ChemClear and we will keep you informed of the progress of our funding submission.

Your ChemClear registration can be, added too, subtracted from or cancelled at any time.

You will be required to store the chemicals safely until advised of the collection day scheduled in your Shire Council area.

Some Councils may be accepting chemical waste as part of their clean up initiatives. Every Council is different, so please check with yours.

ChemClear will advise each registrant of the collection date and pick up location when a collection is scheduled.
